Park Rules & Regulations

Please be observant of the following rules when visiting the park:

1. Park hours are from sunrise to sunset, unless there is a special event.
2. No littering.
3. No parking cars in the picnic grove area.
4. No alcoholic beverages on the park premises.
5. No bike riding on the park premises.
6. The removal of park benches from the grove area is prohibited.
7. No playing of golf on the park premises.
8. No soda bottles are allowed on the park premises.
9. No dogs allowed on the park premises.
