Each individual banner will be unique and honor a specific Shoemakersville Veteran. It will include their picture, rank, branch of service and era of service. The program is non-political and non-partisan. It is solely a living memorial to those men and women from the Borough of Shoemakersville who have served our great country.

The initial batch of Hometown Heroes Banners will be hung in early spring of 2020. We are required to have a minimum order of 15 or more banners in order to place an order. With Met-Ed's help between 75-90 poles have already been designated.

The banners will remain hanging for a period of 3-5 years or until they become worn or tattered. Banners are \$200 each. Sponsor's name will be placed at the bottom of the banner if desired.
