### Leaves and Outdoor Fireplaces

#### Keep the Streets Clean

Borough staff cleans leaves that naturally fall into the roadway and gutters.

However, leaves and yard sweepings should not be swept into the streets, as it may clog the storm sewers. This can create slippery conditions, flooding and water quality issues. When the system becomes blocked with grass clippings and leaves, it creates a flooding potential that could result in property damage.

#### Burning in the Borough

Please remember that per Borough Ordinance 429-2012, all outdoor fireplaces and/or outdoor cooking appliances must be set at least 5' from any structure vertically, as well as horizontally. The burning of designated recyclables and yard waste is not permitted. A violation would occur when any smoke or ash emission are or may be objectionable, offensive or deleterious to human or animal health or permeate or cross into neighboring properties and or falls on buildings, vehicles, or vegetation.
