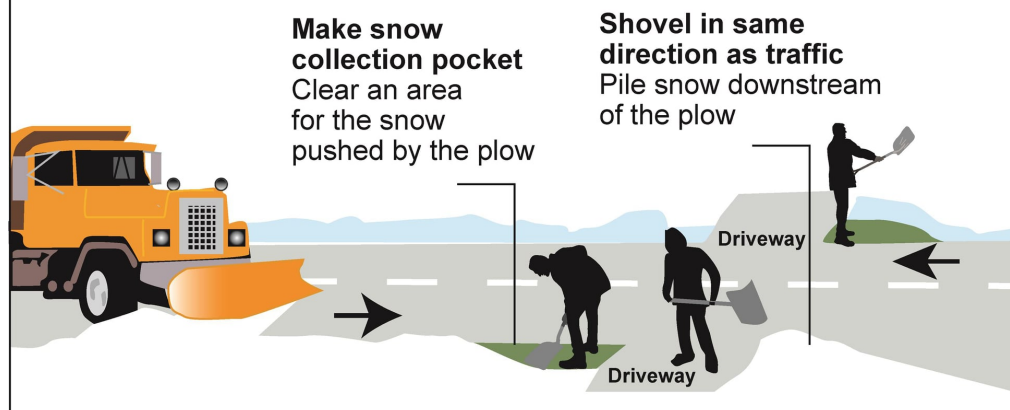
Snow Shoveling and Plowing

Snow Shoveling

Please be mindful of the following excerpt from Ordinance 341-94: "...The owner, occupant or tenant of every property fronting upon or alongside any street or alley in the Borough of Shoemakersville is hereby required to remove or cause to be removed from all the sidewalks in front of or alongside such property all snow and ice thereon fallen or formed, **within twenty-four (24) hours** after the same shall have ceased to fall or to be formed, so as to leave a clear walkway at least two feet (2') wide..."

A smarter way to shovel your drive

How to shovel your driveway to avoid having snow pushed back in when snowplows clear your street:



Snow Plowing

Plowing is just around the corner. We prefer to plow curb to curb. If possible, please move your vehicle off of the street during snow removal. This is beneficial to all, as it will create more parking and less shoveling out of cars. Please note that it is against borough ordinance to put snow into the street. Snow should be placed either on your private property or on the curb side of the walk.

During a snow emergency, vehicles must be removed from the snow emergency route, which includes the entire length of Main St., Noble Ave from Main St. to Route 61 and Franklin St., from Church Ave. to Noble Ave.

Emergency Notification System



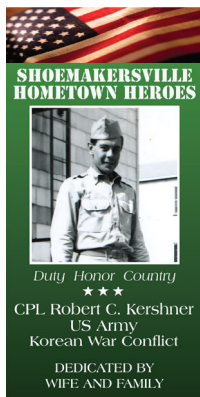
Have you signed up to receive calls through the CodeRED system?
