Spring Reminders

Outdoor Regulations-

Yard Waste Pick-up

Yard waste pick-up will begin on April 3. Please remember to use a biodegradable paper bag for the waste. The weight of the bags should not exceed 30 pounds. Tree branches and sticks should be bundled together, with a length not to exceed 3 feet. Be sure to have your items at the curbside by 7:00 a.m. on Tuesday mornings, in order to assure proper pick-up. The Borough asks that you do not sweep leaves and yard waste into the streets, as it may clog the storm sewers. This can create slippery conditions, flooding, and water quality issues. When the system becomes blocked with grass clippings and leaves, it creates a flooding potential that could result in property damage.



Yard Maintenance

Now that Spring is arriving, remember the following:

- Weeds, grass or other uncultured vegetation not edible or planted for some useful or ornamental purpose, shall be no more than ten inches (10") in height when measured from the surface of the ground, provided that weed growth on lawns occurring between mowings shall not constitute a nuisance.
- Trees, shrubs, hedges or other vegetation overhanging sidewalks or other pedestrian walkways must be higher than eight feet (8').
- Trees, shrubs or other vegetation overhanging a road right-of-way must be higher than sixteen feet (16), measured from the street surface at the curb.

Berks County Household Hazardous Waste

The program will be held on April 14th at the Governor Mifflin Intermediate School from 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. Acceptable materials for disposal include oil based paints (turpentine, paint thinners, wood preservatives), weed killers and pesticides, pool chemicals, antifreeze, gasoline and motor oil. Please do not take joint and caulking compound, lead acid batteries or water based sealants. For latex paint, you should allow the material to dry and then discard it with your regular trash.
