## **Shoemakersville Pool Updated Policies for 2020 Season**

Due to the need for social distancing and recommendations by the CDC, Department of Health and other governing agencies coupled with the anticipation of additional patrons from other pools, the following protocols will be in place:

- Capacity will be limited to 125 people.
  - o "Kids Zone" will be limited to 45 patrons
  - "Center Zone" will be limited to 62 patrons
  - Lap lanes will be limited to 1 person per lane
  - "Deep Corner" will be limited to 16 patrons
- Entry will be limited to season pass holders only for at least the first two weeks.
- Pass holders will need to sign up in advance for 3 hour time slots.
- Diving board will be open, but the slide and climbing wall will be closed temporarily.
- Snack bar will also be closed, but small personal coolers will be allowed. Patrons may bring their
  own food and drink and are responsible for proper disposal. Food is not permitted on the deck
  and bottles, crockery, glassware, or other hazardous objects shall not be permitted within the
  pool fence area. Food trucks will be invited and information regarding times will be posted.
- Masks will be highly encouraged for entry, exit and bathrooms. Masks are NOT to be worn in the actual pool.
- "High touch" surfaces including ladders, the diving board, and the bathrooms will be sanitized frequently. Top to bottom deep sanitizing of the bathrooms and all surfaces will be done before opening and once during the day.
- "Shared objects" such as toys, balls, etc. will not be allowed to be shared outside of your "family unit".
- No roughhousing, wrestling or other bodily contacts will be allowed outside of your "family unit".
- Social distancing guidelines will remain in place at all times. Please allow at least 6 feet of space between you and anyone outside of your family unit.
- Signage will be spread around the facility regarding COVID-19 and the CDC guidelines. There will be an information board in the breezeway should you want more information than what is provided here.
- If you are not feeling well STAY HOME. Should you start to not feel well while at the pool please report to a staff member immediately so that accommodations can be made as necessary.
- If you are diagnosed with COVID-19 and have been at our facility in the last 14 days please notify us immediately.

We will continually monitor and make adjustments as necessary. Information about protocols, rules and other procedures will be posted at the pool, on the Borough Website and Shoey Pool Facebook Page.

## **Shoemakersville Pool Rules**

**General Rules** 

### **Reglas Generales**

Persons with skin, eye, or nasal infections; open cuts or wounds or communicable diseases are not allowed to enter the pool.

No se permiten en la piscina las personas con infecciones de piel, ojos o nariz; cortes de gravedad o enfermedades contagiosas.

Proper swimming attire required. Shorts or suits not made for swimming are not permitted to be worn in pool.

Se necesita traje de baño apropiado. No se permiten pantalones cortos que no son trajes de baño.

Any persons suspected of being under the influence of alcohol or drugs shall be prohibited from entering the pool.

No se permiten personas borrachas o bajas la influencia de alcohol o drogas en la piscina.

Spitting, urinating, defecating, blowing of the nose, spouting of water or deposit of foreign matter into pool shall be strictly prohibited.

Se prohibe severamente escupir, orinar, defecar, sonarse la nariz, arrojar en chorro o poner materiales extraños.

Only small personal coolers shall be permitted. Bottles, crockery, glassware, or other hazardous objects shall not be permitted within the pool fence area.

Solo se puede tener enfriadores pequeños. No se permiten botellas, contenedores de vidrio, o otros objetos peligrosos dentro de la zona de piscina.

No littering.

No ensuciar.

Children under 9 must be accompanied by an adult to enter. Children not potty trained must wear a water resistant swim diaper. No children should be in the pool without adult supervision.

Menores de 9 deben de ser acompañados por un adulto. Niños que no saben ir al baño deben ponerse un pañal de nadar.

An adult must be in direct physical contact with a non-swimmer, even if they are wearing a floatation device.

Un adulto debe estar en contacto con una persona que no sabe nadar, incluso se se porta un aparato de flotación.

No running, horseplay or foul language will be tolerated.

No se permite correr, hacer payasadas o decir palabrotas.

No loitering.

Prohibido de merodear.

Bikes, skateboards and rollerblades are not permitted within pool area.

No se permiten bicicletas y patines en línea en el área de piscina.

No water guns or other toys that may cause injury to others will be permitted.

Prohibidas pistolas de agua o otros juguetes que pueden causar heridas.

Consumption of food and or beverages and use of tobacco products shall not be permitted in the swimming pool or on the deck area.

Use of pool shall be prohibited during severe weather conditions, i.e. electrical storms, tornadoes, etc. **No se permite nadar durante una tormenta.** 

Do not hang on ropes or lane lines.

No diving is permitted into shallow areas of the pool.

Lap Lane Rules

Las reglas de carillas

Keep off the lane lines.

No toque las líneas de carril.

Adults have priority for lap lane use.

Lap swimmers should share the lanes with other lap swimmers.

Nadadores deben compartir las líneas de carril con otros nadadores.

Do not interfere with lap swimmers by crossing or swimming under the lap lanes.

Toys must be kept out of the lap lanes.

Deep Well Rules

Deep well is closed to swimming unless authorized by management.

Use of diving board is restricted to patrons able to swim length of the deep well unaided.

One person on board at a time.

Una persona a la vez sobre la trampolin.

Forward diving only.

Saltar de cabeza sólo hacia delante.

One bounce on board per dive.

Sólo un rebote en el trampolín por salto de cabeza.

No dangerous or trick dives.

Prohibidos saltos de cabeza al agua peligrosos.

Swim to closest ladder.

Favor de nadar a la escalera más cercana.

No arm floats, tubes or other devices not part of swimsuit will be allowed to be worn when going off the board. Suits containing devices and management approved life vests with proper straps will be permitted.

No se permiten aparatos para flotar que no son un parte de un traje de baño cuando se salta del trampolín. Se permiten trajes que contienen aparatos acreditado con correas apropiadas.

Children using devices must be accompanied by an adult. No exceptions.

Niños usando aparatos deben ser acompañados por un adulto. Sin exceptión.

No full mask goggles.

No se permiten gafas de submarinismo de máscara completa.

Lifeguard may close the deep well at any time.
