February 7, 2021

Vice President Botwright called the special teleconference of the Shoemakersville Borough Council to order at 5:08 p.m.

In attendance: Amy Botwright –Vice President, Dana Randazzo, Dana Smith, Joseph Wertz, Jr., and Melissa Wagner – Secretary/Treasurer.

Absent from the meeting: Chris Kline - President, Tara Kennedy-Kline, John Leshner, Dustin Remp - Mayor

Executive Session

The Board recessed into executive session at 5:09 p.m. to discuss a real estate transaction. Regular session reconvened at 5:15 p.m.

*A motion is made by Mr. Wertz to instruct Berkshire Hathaway to make an offer for the purchase of 846 Main St. Shoemakersville and to negotiate that purchase in the parameters discussed, and to authorize the Council President and Vice President to execute all documents and issue any payments as required. Seconded by Ms. Randazzo. Motion carried by a vote of 3 yes to 1 abstain, with Ms. Randazzo abstaining.

Mr. Wertz discusses the recent snow emergency. Mr. Smith explains that the snow removal was only for the corners along the snow emergency route, and not for the entire route itself. Ms. Randazzo lives on the south end of Main St. and states that the snow at the intersection near her was not removed, so that perhaps the contractor is not yet finished.

Mr. Wertz notes of the forecasted snow for the forthcoming week and would like Council to consider removing all snow along the snow emergency route. Council discusses the upcoming weather. Vice President Botwright suggests obtaining quotes for any additional work. Mr. Wertz will speak with the streets committee and Mr. Zimmerman regarding the weather and the work needed.

There being no further business, a motion is made by Mr. Wertz to adjourn the meeting. Seconded by Mr. Smith. Meeting adjourned at 5:24 p.m.
